Thank you for your interest in taking part in the mammal survey in Crane Park. This is the final part of the community learning project that has been taking place all year.

The session will be led by Alison Fure who is an ecological consultant (www.furesfen.co.uk) qualified to carry out these activities. We have been working with Alison to draw up the programme for the survey weekend.

We will require volunteers for the following sessions to set up 30 small mammal traps, check them and record findings and then pack the traps away at the end of the weekend. Alison will give full instructions on animal ecology and animal handling as part of the activity. There will be a full risk assessment and animal handling instructions as part of the training. Reserve dates if the weather is unsuitable for trapping will be 14th—16th September. We will let you know if this is the case nearer the time.
