

Please help survey outfalls on the River Crane and Yeading Brook



Citizen Crane water quality data gathered by volunteers shows that ammonia is found in the river at concentrations that are damaging to its wildlife. There are over 150 surface water outfalls into the river and some of these are the likely source of much of this pollution.

We are looking for volunteers to help conduct the Crane's first **Outfall Safari** by surveying stretches of the river and, with the help of a mobile app, mapping and recording the impact of each outfall. This survey will greatly improve our understanding of the river system and help to target the most polluting sources

Together we can map the whole catchment

You can choose which stretch of the river you want to survey and bring your friends (no lone surveying)
